



MIAMISBURG BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION GYM RULES

Gym time is difficult to come by and we do not want to abuse our privileges. All players, parents and coaches are required to follow the rules as listed below. Failure to do so could result in suspension from the league.

1. When school is closed, for any reason, there will be no scheduled practices and/or games in the buildings. This includes school district holiday schedule. For closures due to inclement weather, our primary focus is preparing the school for the next academic day. School closure are announced in various media formats (radio and TV) along with the district using the Call Notification process which is done for every student attending our school system
2. All individuals are to be in the gymnasium only. Individuals should not be roaming and/or playing in hallways/Library-Media Center/Classroom spaces and/or restrooms.
3. Parents must wait with their child until the coach arrives for practice. The coach is responsible for waiting after practice with any players until all parents arrive.
4. Other children brought by parents must follow all gym rules and be accompanied at all times by the adult that brought them. To assist with this, coaches should appoint a parent to be responsible for keeping the halls clear for each practice.
5. Any/all materials taken into the gymnasium, by the organization and/or parents, are to be removed at the end of their session. Any type of container (water bottle/Gatorade/Powerade/etc.) and/or trash is to be placed into the appropriate trash receptacles and/or taken with the group upon leaving the facility.
6. Individuals should not be climbing/hanging/playing on Physical Education equipment and/or utilizing district Physical Education equipment.
7. If a coach cancels practice there is to be notification to the district. The primary contact is Mrs. Debbie Bulger. This is so we can properly notify the building administrator and other building personnel of this issue.

8. Coaches are expected to leave the gym in the same condition as before the practice. Players and their parents will be held responsible for any damages to the gym or school.
9. Those utilizing the facility are to provide adult supervision in the gymnasium and any other area at all times. No children are to be in any area of the building unsupervised by an adult (age 18 or above).
10. In the event that any misconduct is brought to the attention of the Board, a warning will be issued to the head coach of that team. Further violations may result in league suspension.
